<b>Technology</b> eg. look at access, internet use, smart phone, rate of technological change, STEM.				
<b>Legal</b> eg. look at changes to legislation that may impact employment opportunities, access to resources, imports and exports, type and rate of taxation.				

<b>Environmental</b> eg. look at impact of climate change on participation and access to resources, quality of resources, supply chain and other business opportunities.
